General Terms and Conditions for Participants

1. Scope

The following General Terms and Conditions set forth the terms and conditions for participation in the 38th Symposium of the German-Chinese Society for Medicine (DCGM), the Chinese-German Society for Medicine (CDGM), and the China Center at Kiel University (CAU) in cooperation with the German-Chinese Society for Nursing (DCGP), to be held October 16–18, 2026, in Kiel—hereinafter referred to as the “Event.” These General Terms and Conditions apply to every person participating in the Event. The organizer of the conference is the German-Chinese Society for Medicine e. V. | Herbert-Lewin-Platz 1 | 10623 Berlin – hereinafter referred to as the Organizer. The Organizer has commissioned event lab. GmbH | Richard-Lehmann-Str. 12 | 04275 Leipzig to handle participant registration.

2. Conference Participation/Registration

Registration takes place via the event website and becomes binding upon submission of the online registration form to event lab. GmbH. After online registration, the participant will receive a booking confirmation and, within 5 business days, an email with a payment request. This email contains the bank account details. Payment can also be made by credit card (Mastercard/Eurocard, VISA), PayPal, or Google/Apple Pay. Once payment has been made, the participant is entitled to participate in the event program. Please note that some events have limited participant capacity (see No. 6).

3. Event/Registration Fees

Registration fees can be found on the respective event website. If a discount is available for students, they must present a student ID that is valid at the time of registration and for the duration of the event. Upon receipt of the booking confirmation, a copy of the student ID must be submitted to event lab. GmbH immediately and without being asked.

4. Name tag

Participants will receive their name tags at the registration desk. All participants must wear their name tags in a visible manner throughout the event. Entry to the event will not be permitted without a name tag. A processing fee of €15.00 will be charged for the replacement of a misplaced or lost name tag.

5. Rescheduling/Cancellation/Refund

Cancellations must be submitted to event lab. GmbH in writing by mail, fax, or email. Cancellations made on or before August 21, 2026, are free of charge. After August 21, 2026, cancellation fees equal to the registration fee will apply. No refund of the registration fee will be issued in the event of no-show, illness, early departure, etc. Please note that rebookings to a substitute participant(s) are permitted. The organizer is entitled to offset the value of the expenses saved as well as any benefits derived from booking the event elsewhere. However, the participant is permitted to provide evidence that event lab. GmbH incurred no loss at all or a significantly lower loss.

6. Participation Limits/Evening Events/Side Program

Some parts of the event (workshops, evening events, etc.) may have limited capacity, require registration, and incur an additional fee on top of the regular event fee. If registration and/or fees are required, these parts of the event can also be booked and paid for on the event website or at the event/conference office. Information on this is available on the event website or from the event organizer. There is no guarantee of participation in any part of the event once the maximum number of participants has been reached.

Cancellation of the parts of the event with limited participation is only possible until *August 21, 2026*. It is expressly noted that rebookings to a substitute participant is possible. The organizer must be credited with the value of the expenses saved as well as any benefits it derives from another event booking. However, the participant is permitted to provide evidence that event lab. GmbH incurred no loss at all or a significantly lower loss. The organizer reserves the right to withdraw from its offer if the minimum number of participants for the supporting program is not reached. In this case, the amount already paid will be refunded in full.

7. Liability

a) The liability of the Organizer or event lab. GmbH, with the exception of liability for injury to the life, body, or health of the Participant, is limited to cases of intentional misconduct and gross negligence. This does not affect the liability of the Organizer or event lab. GmbH for breaches of material contractual obligations (cardinal obligations). In this case, liability is limited to the amount of damage typical for the contract and foreseeable at the time the contract was concluded. To the extent that the liability of the Organizer or event lab. GmbH is excluded or limited, this also applies to the liability of representatives as well as any vicarious agents or assistants engaged. The Organizer or event lab. GmbH shall not be liable for damages or disruptions caused by circumstances beyond their control. This applies in particular if the event is impeded or prevented by unforeseen political, economic, or climatic events, or generally by force majeure.

b) The organizer is responsible for the event program and its content. The organizer reserves the right to make changes to the program or event, such as due to speaker cancellations. The organizer shall not be liable for the program or event content, any changes thereto, or any resulting damages. To the extent that the organizer is responsible for the printing or digital creation and publication of an event program booklet, newsletter, email, or similar, it shall be liable, in particular with regard to any printing or production errors, etc., exclusively within the scope of the liability provisions of Section 7(a) of the General Terms and Conditions.

8. Privacy and Copyright

The participant acknowledges that the organizer may take photographs and audio recordings at any time and expressly consents to this by registering for the event. The participant also consents to the use of these images by the organizers on the event website, social media channels, and in event publications.

Speakers are expressly advised that the organizer is not liable for any copyright infringements committed by speakers in their presentations.

9. Right of Withdrawal for Consumers

If the participant is a consumer as defined in Section 13 of the German Civil Code (BGB), the following applies:

Withdrawal Policy

Right of Withdrawal:

The participant may withdraw from the contract within 14 days without providing a reason, in any form, in accordance with § 355 (1) (2) of the German Civil Code (BGB). The withdrawal period is fourteen days from the date the contract is concluded.

Consequences of Withdrawal:

In the event of cancellation, any benefits received by either party must be returned, and any benefits derived must be surrendered. Any obligations to refund payments must be fulfilled within 30 days. For the participant, this period begins when the notice of cancellation is sent; for event lab. GmbH, it begins upon receipt of the notice.

10. Miscellaneous

To the extent permitted by law, Leipzig is agreed upon as the place of performance and venue.

11. Severability Clause

If one or more provisions of these Terms and Conditions are invalid or contain a loophole, the parties shall replace or supplement the invalid or incomplete provision with the statutory provisions that most closely correspond to the intended purpose of the provision. The validity of the remaining provisions shall remain unaffected.
